Cross shot two even par rounds of 72, 72 to win the event by two strokes over defending champion, Tim Gavrich. Gavrich, who held the first round lead after carding a two under 70, was the Indian River County Champion after shooting 76 in the final round.

Defending senior champion, Tim Kelly, successfully defended his title with rounds of 74, 73 to win his fifth senior title in eight years.

Golf Cart Policy Change Effective November 1st

The onset of the COVID – 19 pandemic has brought with it unique challenges for our business as a golf club, compelling us to operate under stringent economic conditions to provide a relatively low health risk recreational value to the general public. Due to the economic setback Sandridge Golf Club can no longer maintain the “one cart, one golfer” policy and provide a single cart to golfers.

Despite these economic challenges, since re-opening on May 1st, Sandridge Golf Club has remained open for play, while maintaining strict safety guidelines and protocols as set by the Governor’s Office through Executive Order. We have provided and maintained a safe, clean, and comfortable environment for all of our golfers, members, and staff, during this unprecedented health crisis.

Rest assured that we will continue to maintain all of the sanitary and safety policies, including the sanitization of our golf carts. However, beginning on Sunday, November 1st our Cart Policy will revert back to Two Players in a Cart. ALL golf carts will have a plastic divider installed in them for your safety. Sandridge Golf Club has always provided our golfers with exceptional course conditions and have done so at incredibly affordable prices, providing tremendous value to all of our golfers. In order to continue to maintain this incomparable value and our current price structure, we have found it necessary to revert back to a “two players in a cart” policy.

Saturday Blitz

Local players wanting to play competitively are playing every week at the Sandridge Golf Club Thursday and Saturday Blitz. The Blitz begins at 8:00 A.M. every Saturday (18 holes) and alternates courses every week.

All players play an individual Stableford format, point quota system. A bogey is worth one point, par – two points, birdie – four points, eagle – eight points, and a double eagle or hole in one is worth sixteen points.

Players must sign up by Thursday at 6:00 P.M. in order to play in the Saturday blitz. The cost per player is \$60.00 for the 18 hole Blitz through April. If you are interested in playing in the Blitz or want more information, you may call the Pro Shop at 770-5000 ext 2.

Sunday Couples League

The Sandridge Golf Club Couples' League plays every Sunday afternoon. Every week, the group starts at the same time with a 2:30 PM Shotgun Start. The format is a two person scramble with a points quota format. For instance, for a bogey you get 1 point, par 2 points, birdie 4 points, eagle 6 points. The first time you play, you are qualifying to see how many points you make and then after the first round, you play to your quota and it is adjusted based on how many points you make that day.

2020-21 Sandridge County Card

The 2020-2021 Sandridge County Cards are valid from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021. Sandridge Card Holders receive a reduced rate for greens fees (as much as \$10.00 in the winter), eight day advance tee times, and a reduced rate for the Handicap System.

This year in order to be eligible to purchase a Sandridge County Card, you must have one of the following proofs of residency: (1) Valid Florida driver's license with an Indian River County address; (2) Indian River County Registration Card; or (3) Property Tax Bill/Receipt. The cost to renew or purchase a Sandridge Card will be \$50.00 plus tax for Indian River County Residents. **Utility bills are not accepted.**

We also offer a Florida Card for \$75.00 plus tax or Florida residents. Florida Card holders will receive the same rate and six day advance reservations. To be eligible to purchase a Florida Card, you must meet one of the three criteria mentioned above with a Florida address. As in past years, you can renew your County Cards online at www.golfsandridge.com beginning on October 1st. Click on "Buy Online" at the top of the web page and you will see the County Card renewal icon. This feature will only be for renewals. only and not for new County Cards.
