

2022 Sandridge ID Cards

The 2021-2022 Sandridge County Cards will be sold starting October 1st and will valid from October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. Sandridge Card Holders receive a reduced rate for greens fees (as much as \$10.00 in the winter), eight day advance tee times, and a reduced rate for the Handicap System.

This year in order to be eligible to purchase a Sandridge County Card, you must have one of the following proofs of residency: (1) Valid Florida driver's license with an Indian River County address; (2) Indian River County Registration Card ; or (3) Property Tax Bill/Receipt. The cost to renew or purchase a Sandridge Card will be \$50.00 plus tax for Indian River County Residents. **Utility bills are not accepted.**

We also offer a Florida Card for \$75.00 plus tax or Florida residents. Florida Card holders will receive the same rate and six day advance reservations. To be eligible to purchase a Florida Card, you must meet one of the three criteria mentioned above with a Florida address. As in past years, you can renew your County Cards online at www.golfsandridge.com beginning on October 1st. Click on "Buy Online" at the top of the web page and you will see the County Card renewal icon. This feature will only be for renewals only and not for new County Cards

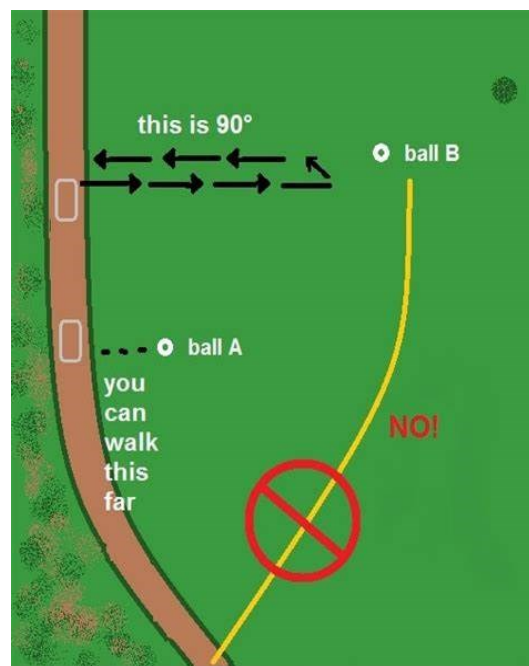

Pollock/Ismail Win 23rd Annual Summer Team Championship

Tom Pollock and Waheed Ismail had to go extra time to win the 23rd Annual Summer Team Championship after the pair was tied with Ryan Cobb and Evan English through 18 holes after both teams finished with six under 66's. Pollock then stepped up and nailed a drive on the first playoff hole, Hole #16 Dunes, to the collar of the green where he two putted for birdie and the team victory. Defending champions Frank and Mike DelRocco finished six strokes back.

A record forty-seven teams competed in the event which featured three different formats every six holes including Modified Pinehurst on holes #1 through #6; Scramble on holes #7 through #12 and Better Ball of Partners on holes #13 through #18. Sandridge To Build New Clubhouse

Sandridge Golf Club is set to build a new 18,000 square foot clubhouse with a restaurant, bar and banquet facilities with an anticipated completion in the Fall of 2023. The new clubhouse will be built in a vacant area just west of the current clubhouse facility which will remain operational until the new building opens. It will then be leveled to create an expanded golf cart staging area and additional parking.

The architectural design which was approved by the County Commission in February, will also increase the parking capacity from 80 paved spaced to 206. The plan also includes construction of a new 1,100 square foot turn station immediately east of the practice green. The facility would offer grab-and-go food service, restrooms and self-service breezeway where golfers can get water and ice.

All players play an individual Stableford format, point quota system. A bogey is worth one point, par – two points, birdie – four points, eagle – eight points, and a double eagle or hole in one is worth sixteen points.

New Clubhouse Continued from Pg 1

Director of Golf, Bela Nagy, County officials are expected to begin seeking bids from construction firms in July and hope to break ground on the \$5.5 million project by early Fall.

The clubhouse project will be funded by user fees generated by Sandridge patrons. If the user-fee funds aren't enough to cover the initial costs, the County will borrow money from another fund with Sandridge paying back the money using future revenues.

The new clubhouse will be equipped with a commercial grade kitchen and two banquet rooms, each of which will set 100 people, as well as a restaurant and bar. The banquet facility will overlook the 18th green of the Lakes Course and the restaurant and bar will overlook the lake between 10 and 18 Lakes.

The additional space will alleviate

the over-crowding experienced with the over 40 events per year that Sandridge hosts that have over 100 participants. More than 112,000 rounds of golf were played on both courses at Sandridge last year. As the County continues to grow, we will now have the facilities to be able to handle and attract new opportunities, such as weddings and other parties. "The Sandridge location certainly has proven to be one of the more coveted governmentally owned golf courses in the state." Commissioner Joe Flescher said. "This shot in the arm will only improve its value and operations."
